The natural and positive law detailed therein is the only law we are obliged to observe as natural men/women of living spirit in a world of substance under the Laws of God.

Enactments of legislation and statutes are in the fictional rules of a society by corporations (of which a PERSON is a kind of corporation, construed as a Trust). The law of nations is derived from our rights and obligations as men/women, because we, as Sovereign individuals are of the same status as sovereign states.

Legislation, on the other hand, is created by man, and (maxim) "the created can never be greater than the creator". We have been tricked by Roman cult devices over centuries into believing we are subservient to the authority of the State. (the State means an estate. Estate means it's a Trust. A trust means it's a corporation.) And as such corporations are only bound by contracts (or treaties) we have entered into, either by knowing-consent or legal obfuscation.

In this book many of the fundamentals and sources of universal rights and obligations (and papal fraud) are laid bare in a way I have not come across before. I hope you will find it enlightening and pass it on to any other interested parties.
